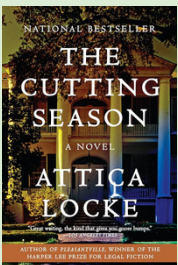

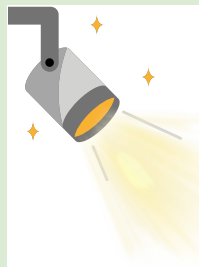

Glenn Engstrom

When he's not reminiscing about his career, Glenn enjoys talking about his love of golf. After retiring, he spent 20 years working at the Edinburgh Golf Course tending golf carts.

One of his proudest accomplishments is writing a manuscript on industrial engineering, allowing him to pass along the knowledge and experience he gained over the years.

When asked why he chose Tradition, Glenn smiled and said he was “closing in on 100” and decided it was the right time to make a move. His home sold in just one day, and after hearing great things from a neighbor who had just moved to Tradition, he knew this was the place for him.
